















The bathroom is finished with a white bath, toilet and sink. The home is kept warm with central heating and double glazing.


On-street parking is available to the front of the property. This charming period home would make an ideal buy for anyone, or fantastic holiday home accommodation.








Known as the Granite Town, Dalbeattie is surrounded by stunning countryside and offers many opportunities to enjoy the outdoors. The annual Hardrock challenge takes place at the Seven Stanes cycling track in Dalbeattie Forest. The thriving yachting village of Kippford, approximately four miles away, is also a short drive from the unspoilt beaches of Rockciffe and Sandyhills. There are several golf courses within and around Dalbeattie, to include the eighteen hole Championship course at Southerness.

Nearby amenities are plentiful and the bustling Food Town of Castle Douglas is approximately six miles away and Dumfries only fourteen.





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
